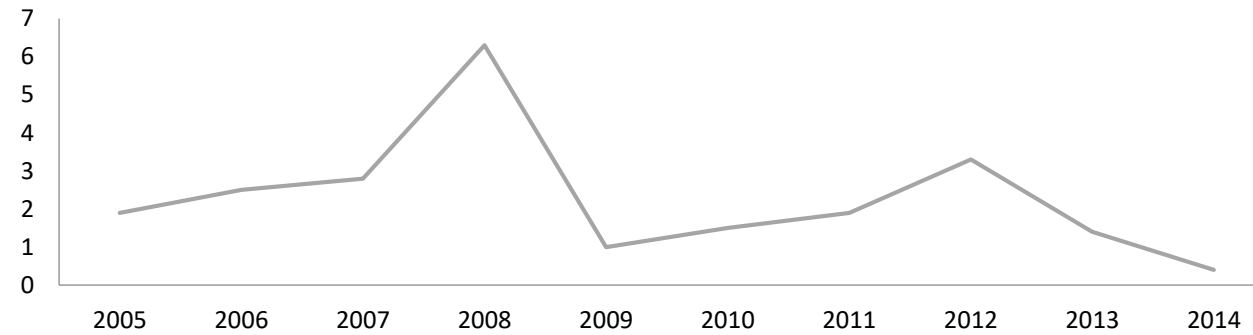

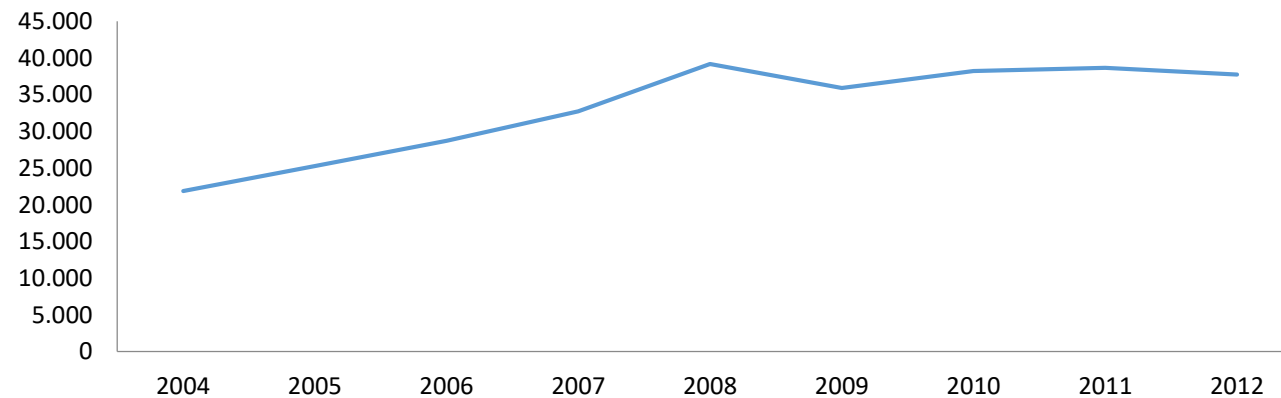

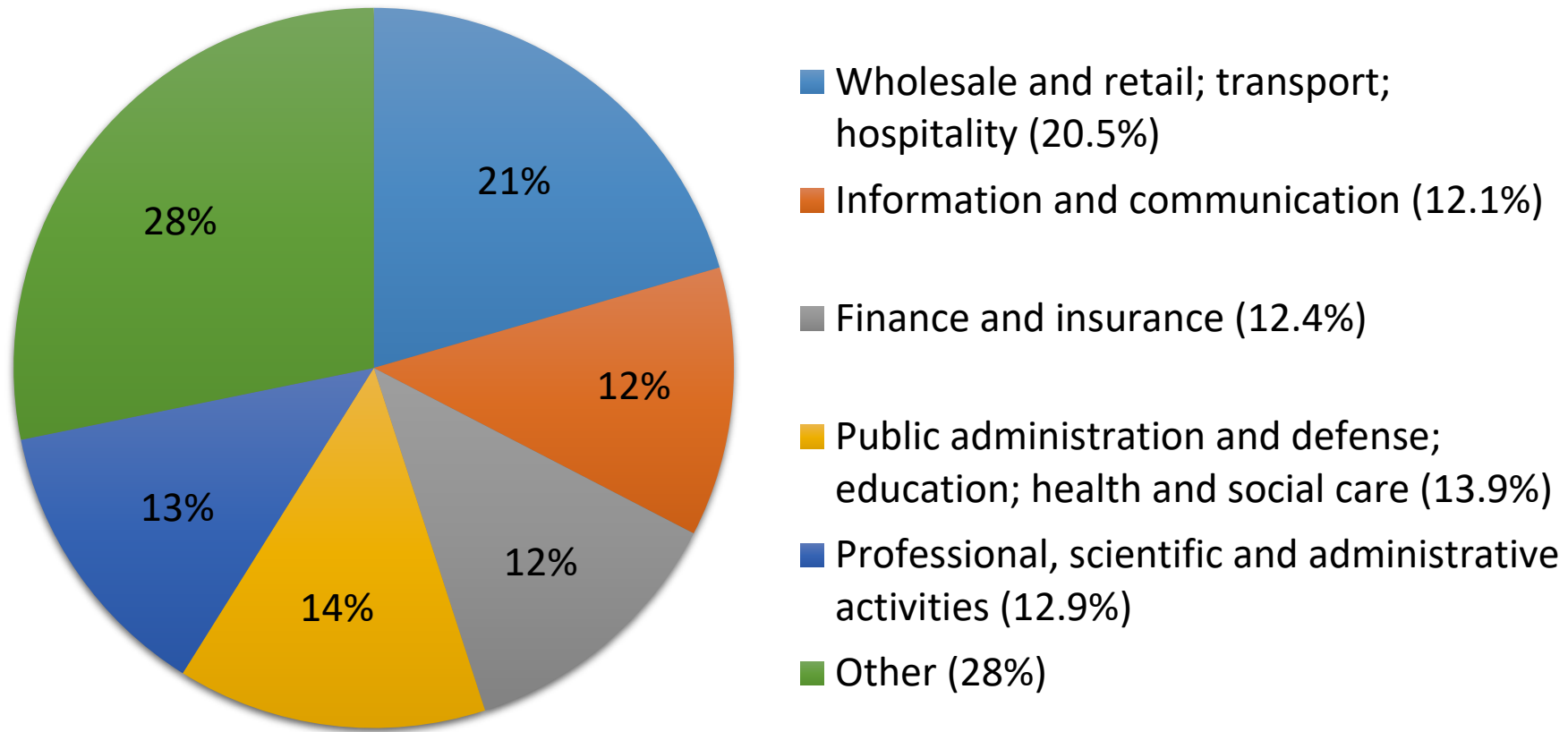
- Average annual inflation rate (%)



- Gross domestic product at current prices (million EUR)



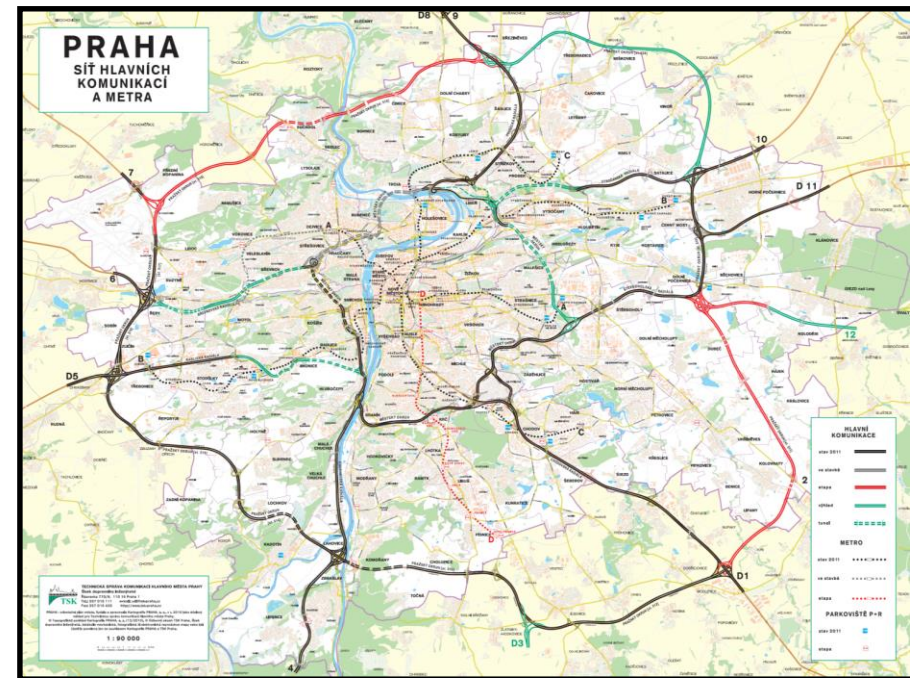
Gross value added by selected CZ-NACE sectors in Prague



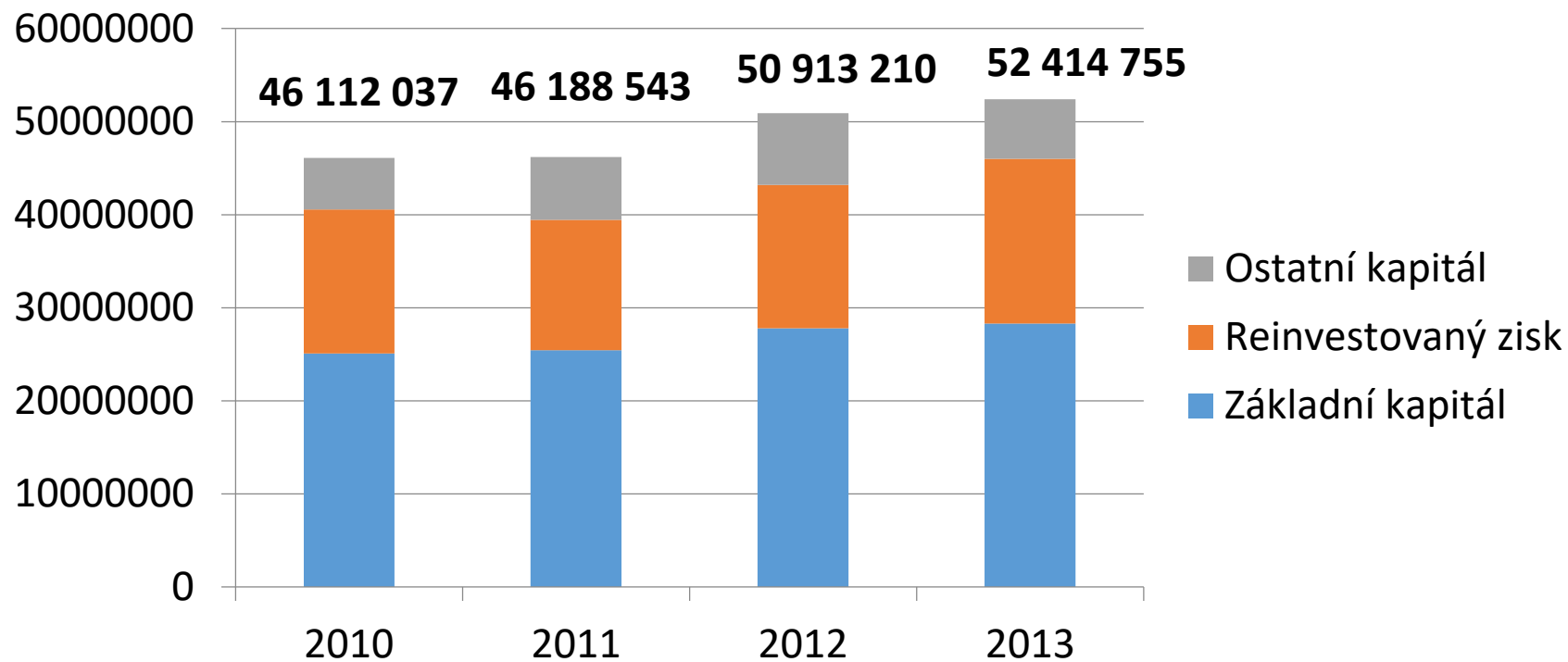
Prague nowadays

- Bus network: 810 km (248 lines)

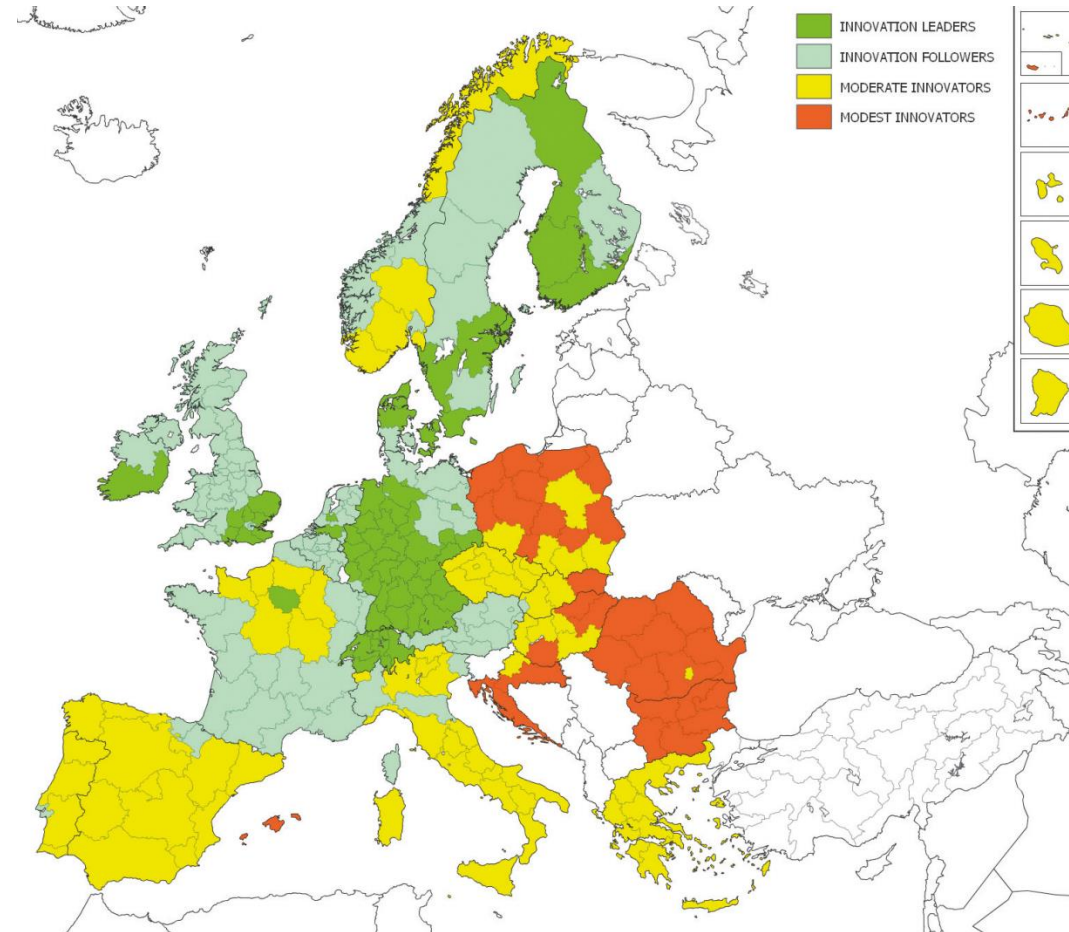


Foreign direct investments in Prague

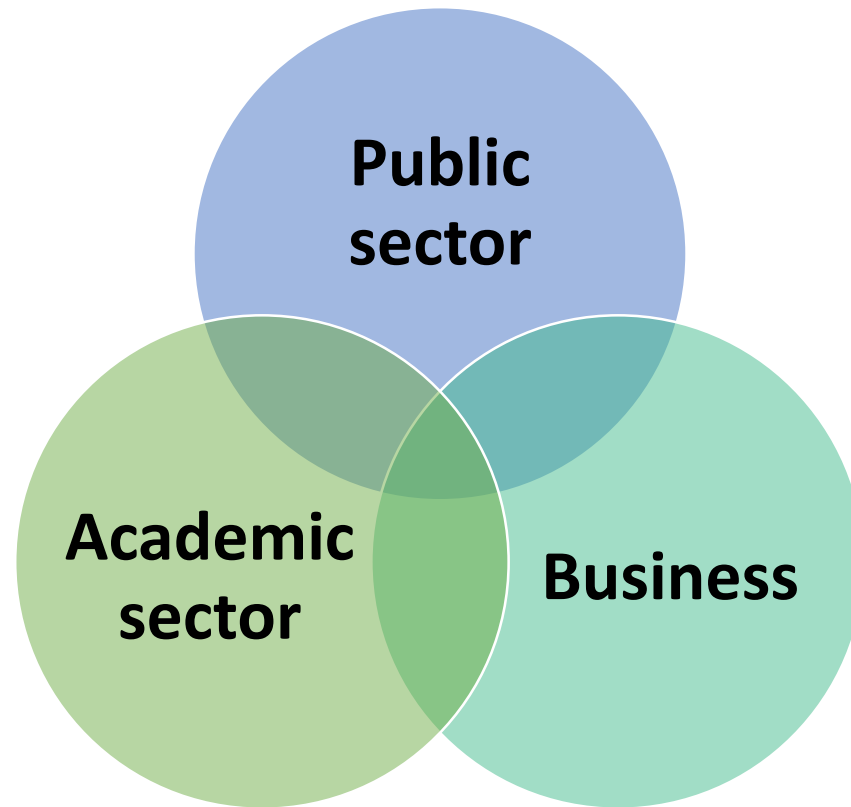

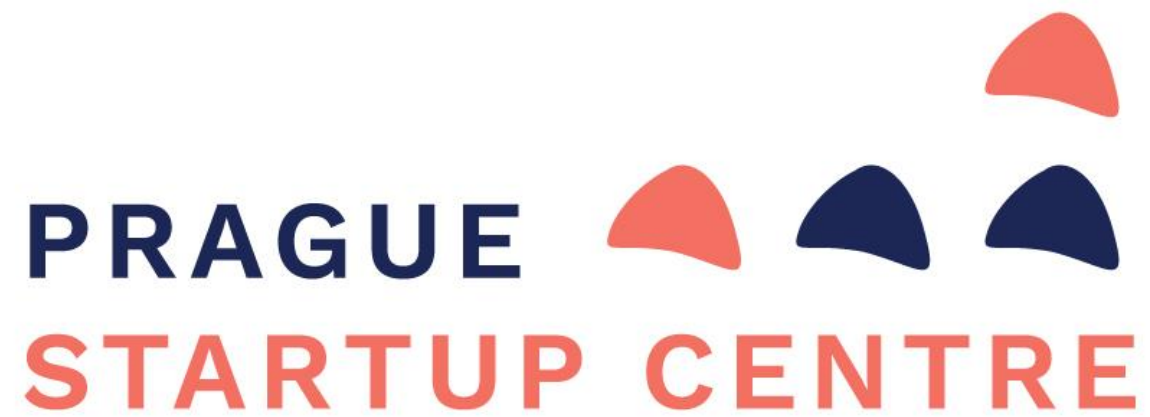

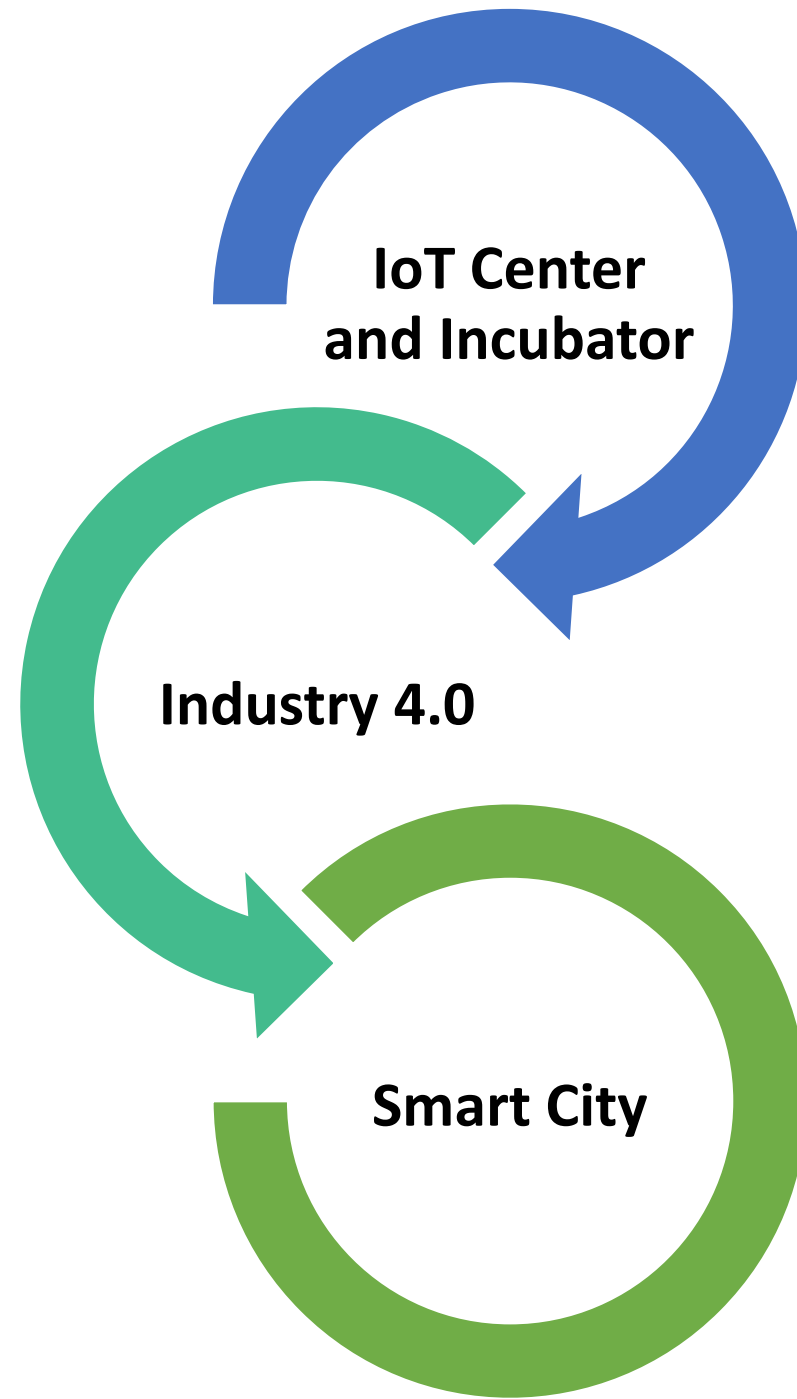
